- The Major emphasis of this course is to motivate students for improvement of their theoretical knowledge and research skills.
- The students will also be encouraged for self-study and preparation for NET Examination.
- Each theory paper will have equal weightage of teaching and self-learning.
- The elective paper will be offered as per availability of the expert faculty and feasibility of the department and schedule of teaching.
